Information for Parents

Please read this information carefully before completing the form

Parents may apply for the non-local enrolment of their child in up to four (4) schools of their choice in addition to their designated local Primary School. A separate application form is required for each school.

Priority for enrolment will be given to students entering Kindergarten. Places may also be available in Years 1-6.

Reasons for choosing non-local placements may include:

- ◆ Brothers or sisters already enrolled at the school
- ◆ Student welfare needs
- ◆ Particular educational programs or philosophy
- ◆ Safety and supervision of the student before and after school
- ◆ Medical reasons with certificate
- ◆ Travel arrangements and/or distance
- ◆ Structure and organisation of the school
- ◆ Size of the school
- ◆ Particular disciplinary procedures
- ◆ Attitude to school uniforms
- ◆ Change of residence
- ◆ Move from a non-government school

The number of students a school may enrol is limited by the availability of classroom space. This means that some schools may not have room left for non-local enrolments after accommodating local children. To avoid disappointment, parents should check that there are places available in a school before applying.

Once a child enrolls in a non-local school, transfer to another non-local school will only be possible in exceptional circumstances.

Transfer to the student's local school will be allowed if space is available.

Parents can appeal against decisions regarding non-local placement by writing to the Cluster Director
