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Technology Pass / ICT Code of Conduct 2020

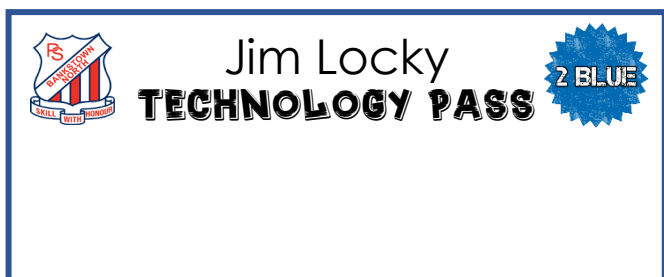
Dear Parents/Caregivers,

To support our school in making annual subscription payments for programs such as **Literacy Planet**, **Mathseeds** and **Mathspace**, and to help cover the cost of general wear and tear of Chromebooks, ipads and other devices used in the classroom, the school is requesting a **Technology Fee of \$25**. The fee is also used to purchase computer software and programs, which are used by all K-6 teachers to assist students with their learning.

In addition to this fee, all students and parents must acknowledge 'Bankstown North Public School Information and Communication Technologies Acceptable Use Policy' and sign the 'ICT Code of Conduct' located on Page 2.

Once **payment** and a **signed copy** of the 'ICT Code of Conduct' have been received by the school, **your child will be issued a 'Technology Pass'**. This pass will give your child access to school-based devices such as Chromebooks and iPads, as well as their logins details for **Literacy Planet**, **Mathseeds** and **Mathspace**.

Your prompt payment of the Technology Fee and return of a signed copy of the 'ICT Code of Conduct' is appreciated.

Years 3-6 Student ICT Code of Conduct

- I will only use technology to help me learn and as instructed by my teacher.
- I will not load or download any of my own software or music onto school Chromebooks, iPads and other devices.
- I will not delete any software or files that do not belong to me.
- I will not change any settings on Chromebooks, iPads and other devices.
- I will only use my own login and password and keep them private.
- I will handle technology equipment with care and immediately report any problems or damage to the teacher.
- I will cover the cost of repair if I am responsible for damaging hardware intentionally or due to a lack of care. **This includes putting stickers on or removing stickers, as well as drawing on my device.**
- I will cover the cost of replacement if my device is lost.
